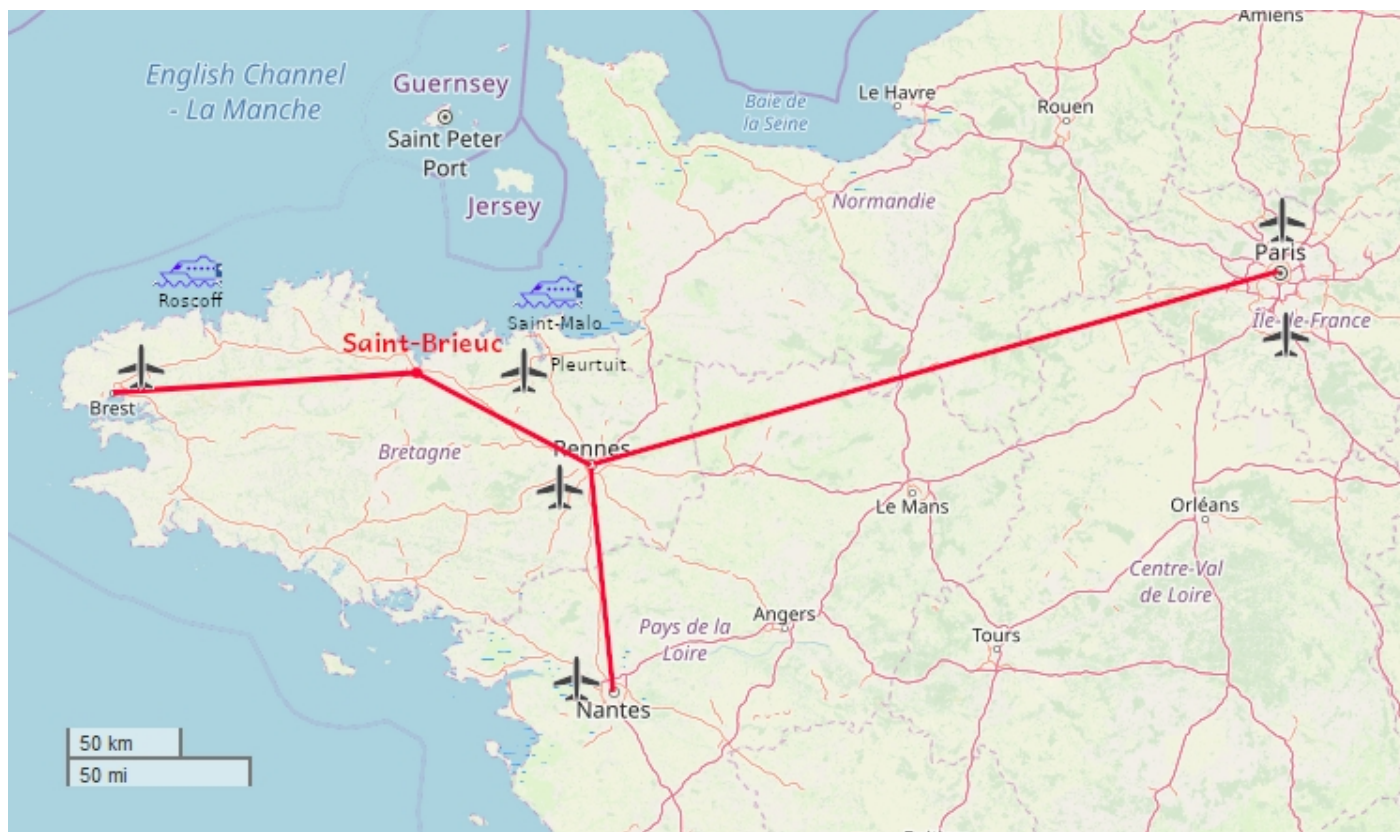
## International Junior Open 2020 Saint-Brieuc (France)

However, because of limited space, we will need to restrict the number of teams per club.

### Directions



- By plane: Paris, Rennes, Brest, Nantes, Pleurtuit (Dinard) airports.
- By train:
  - Paris (Charles de Gaulle (train) or Orly (bus + train)) – Saint-Brieuc 4 hours and 30 minutes
  - Rennes – Saint-Brieuc (bus + train) 2 hours
  - Brest-Guipavas – Saint-Brieuc 2 hours and 40 minutes
  - Nantes (airport) – Saint-Brieuc (2 connections) 3 hours minimum
- By sea: Saint-Malo and Roscoff harbours...

We will do our best to facilitate the “last kilometers” of foreign delegations.
